

Rainwater Basin Bird Check-list

The following is a list of birds that have been observed in the USFWS-managed Waterfowl Production Areas in the Rainwater Basin region. Species presence and abundance may vary considerably from year to year, depending on precipitation, wetland availability, and other natural cycles.

The order of bird species follows that of the American Ornithologists' Union Check-list of North American Birds.

Seasons

Spring (**Sp**) = March-May

Summer (**Su**) = June-August

Fall (**F**) = September – November

Winter (**W**) = December – February

a = abundant (occur in large numbers)

c = common (certain to be seen in suitable habitat)

u = uncommon (present, but not certain to be seen)

o = occasional (seen only a few times during the season)

r = rare (seen at intervals of 2-5 years)

h = hypothetical (within normal range, but never documented)

x = outside normal range (but has been documented)

m = not present during season in question

* = documented nesting on Rainwater Basin WPAs

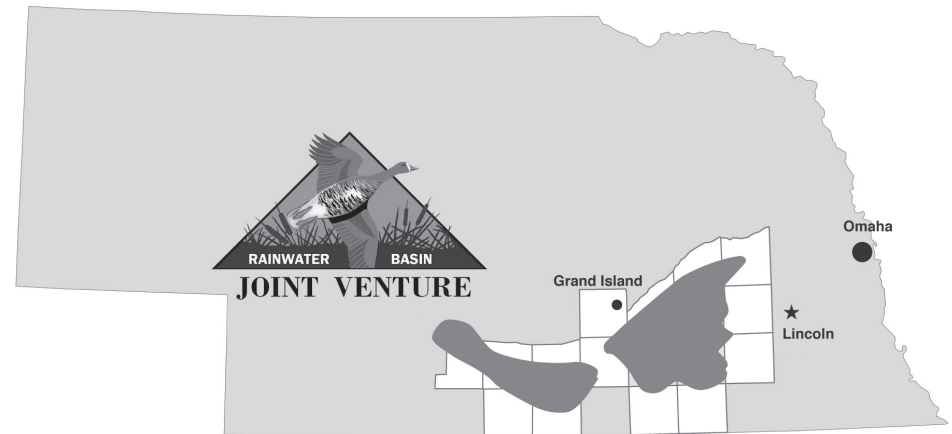
